Dr. Divya Jyoti has published widely and is known for conceptualizing and designing various courses and programmes that interpret learning experience across platforms. A paper on 'Violence against Women in Northern India' she co-authored with scholars from Texas (A&M) University, US was published online in a special issue of *International Journal of Comparative and Applied Criminal Justice* (2016).
