Co-founder: Mr. Himanshu Bhardwaj, a network marketer.

Description: Mr. Rishabh Tiwari came to know about the Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence through a casual visit as he was observing the center from the time of its construction and enquired about the working of same from its Centre Head, Ms. Shilpa Saluja. He was amazed with the amount of benefits this Incubator could have provided him.

Mr. Rishabh Tiwari with a brilliant business mind was planning on an idea which is actually a problem of every common man to wait for longer periods to get their bikes serviced/repared or even in regular bike services.

After getting guided by the team of Startup Incubator, the first thing he did was - market survey of the same and to analyze its demand. After realizing the potential of the idea he took incubation with Startup Incubator and started working under the able guidance of Startup Incubator team - soon he started realizing the requirements of the market and decided to start a platform to people to provide easy and affordable servicing/repair of bikes through an online appointment booking website platform so that it can save time of people which they usually waste at the Bike service stations and roadside service shops. Today, his startup is generating revenue and stands registered by the name of “**RepairiKo-We are here to Repair**” based at Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence, Sector-16 A, Faridabad.

Repairiko is right now connecting with different bike service stations and engaging people in faridabad to get their bikes serviced at affordable price. Also, he is providing a free pick and drop facility to make it more comfortable for end users staying at home.



- **Shining Sparkles**

Founders: - Ms. Shahnaaz & Ms. Sushama, students of Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru College, Faridabad.

Description: While doing one of our startup sensitization session at Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru College, we came across these two students who were randomly discussing about their interest in art & crafts but not with the regular purchased items - to be created out of the waste items. This is when we decided to not to let go of this great idea and conducted an one two one mentoring session with these students and briefed them on how can they can start their own startup/company.

Underlined their hearts there was a same dream of having their own gallery of handicrafts, with this aligned purpose and dream in their eyes they visited Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence, which welcomed them with open heart and mind and instantly started providing the maximum they could , like - space, guidance, support and mentoring which transformed these two simple young girls to be entrepreneurs dealing in handmade items.

With their motto of “Best out of Waste” these young girls started their market research about the latest demand and supply of handmade gifts/ items and started preparing the same, simultaneously working on how they can collect their raw material without spending much and be able to create these unique handicraft items out of waste. Now that they have done their prototype and have also created some inventory of good ready to be sold , they will soon hold a sale exhibition of the same.



- **Small Budget Fashion**

Founders: - Ms. Priyanka, Ms. Sweta & Ms.Pooja, all students of Government College for Women, Faridabad

Description: This team of three young, dynamic and passionate girls got to know about the Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence through the awareness session conducted in the Government College for Women, Faridabad

Amazed with the benefits that the center could give to the students with startup ideas and to all the students who have will to do something of their own. They visited the Startup Incubator and inquired about the complete process of incubation and also inquired about the process of availing the startup benefits, after getting to know about the entire knowhow, they instantly decided to get themselves registered with the startup incubator as a startup under the name and style of **Small Budget Fashion**.

The mission of this Startup “Small Budget Fashion” is to create best outfits at affordable prices created from the leftover or waste cloth pieces (left in the boutiques and stores). To give new dimension to their talent, team incubator encouraged these students to start working on their business plans, financials, customer acquisition and vendor finalization amongst other traits of a business . Presently, they are working on their financials and vendors for raw material to supply in large volumes .

Description: With a believe that every student should have access to daily newspapers and magazines (print media), this team thought of building up a startup to give quick access to newspaper, daily magazines & books etc to the college students.

While they were thinking on how they could work on their idea to make it a viable business , they came to knew about the Startup Incubator cum center of excellence during one the awareness sessions being held at their college and thereby decided to meet the team in the incubation centre itself. After discussing the viability of their business idea and by understanding how can the Startup Incubator help them, they decided to register their idea and the name was instantly coined as “Sanduja Magazines & Newspaper.”

Now with the aim all set in the minds and the eyes of the founders - to provide quick access to print media this team took the next step of procurement of their basic business material i.e newspapers and magazines. Secondly after procurement the plan to earn revenue by giving these on rentals or maybe even sale on affordable rates.

The initial lot they procured was student’s books, fiction, non-fictional, motivational and leadership. Presently, they are working on preparing their database of books procured for further rental and sales plus working on client acquisition thought marketing of their startup via social media and digital marketing.



5. With the increase in awareness about the Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence, we also had many alumni visits resulting in queries related to their businesses and new startup ideas.
6. Students are now showing more interest in visiting the Startup Incubator on a regular basis to discuss and take their idea forward.
7. Facilities of Startup Incubator are now more frequently used by the students for doing their team meetings on their Startups ideas.
8. Team Startup incubator has identified and has started helping the student on the following: -
 - a) Startup Incubator as a co-working place absolutely free of cost.
 - b) Frequent one on one mentoring whenever required by the students
 - c) Startup Incubator and its networks as a platform to connect with local resources.
 - d) Startup Incubator team as a guiding hand on various aspects like idea Selection, Idea Validation, how to prepare a business plan, how to prepare a pitch deck and also things like how to maintain financial books, HR, Sales and ultimately market launch with required legal compliances.

She shared a very basic tip of finding ideas, she told students that it is not always about creating something big or solve some big problems of the world but we need to look at the problems which we face/see in our daily routines and then to find a solution for them which ultimately results in building a business.

She also told the students to believe in what they want to do as without their believe in their own abilities no one else would ever have faith in them. She also shared the important of customer feedback in the development of the business.

3rd Mentoring Session:


Startup Incubator cum Centre of Excellence, Faridabad organized another mentoring session on 19th February 2020 in Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru College.

He is a firm believer of a saying “When the intentions are right accompanied with right temperament and approach, it is pretty much obvious that a person will achieve positive results.”


Faculty Development Program


2nd Faculty Development Program




OUTREACH

We conduct classes on a regular basis catering to the demand of the students in the following manner -


First Session


